Castle & Cooke continues to support measures to provide new transportation systems for Oahu. As a developer of master plan and infill communities throughout the island, regional transportation systems are one of the primary issues we face when providing housing opportunities.

Oahu's rapidly growing West Oahu regions, which encompass Ewa, Leeward and Central Oahu, require additional transportation systems and solutions to alleviate current and future traffic and congestion.
