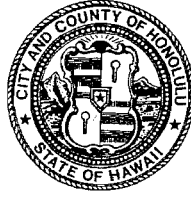

I am Raymond Ancheta, Captain of the Records and Identification Division of the Honolulu Police Department (HPD), City and County of Honolulu.

The HPD supports Senate Bill No. 2263, Relating to Chapter 134.

This bill amends chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), concerning compliance with provisions of the federal law known as the "Brady Bill." This bill requires background checks via the National Instant Background Check System as well as the Immigration and Customs Enforcement databases.

Our department currently adheres to the requirements of the "Brady Bill," and we support the amendment of the HRS to comply with the federal law.

Therefore, the HPD supports and urges you to pass Senate Bill No. 2263 as it reflects the best interest of the public and the police department.
