I want to express my support for SB 2531. I'm concerned SB 2531 doesn't have unanimous support from our law enforcement community.

I'm concerned Police Chief Boise Correia and former Mayor Harris stated the proposed Hawaii Kai Police Station would "create an improved perception of public safety".

I'm concerned; when my daughter was assaulted, the police officer stated when the kids who were arrested with the weapon turned 18 and committed a serious crime, they'd be prosecuted.

I'm concerned the only news our Neighborhood Watch group received about Jesse Dutro, whom we helped arrest with a stolen shotgun, was that he escaped from the police cell block because of defective locks.

I'm concerned the 3 strikes law did not protect Roxanne Kastner who was murdered in Honolulu by a man who had been twice convicted of murder, served time and deemed rehabilitated.

I'm concerned to read a letter from Representative Stonebraker about Glen Gaspar, a Honolulu police officer who was killed by a man who shouldn't have been on our streets.

Please support law abiding citizens and pass this law and restore our rights.
