- 3) Your phone number (optional)
- 4) Your e-mail address to be used on the letter (optional)
- 5) A list of as many of your U.S. mail contacts that are living in Hawaii. This includes the recipient's full name(s) and mailing address.
- 6) A short, personalized message (1-2 sentences) describing how you know David Ige and/or why you are supporting him for governor.

We will use your first and last name, and your home address, (optional phone number and/or optional e-mail address) to address the letter with you as the SENDER.

We will use the list of your U.S. mail contacts to address each letter with each of the addresses you provide as the RECIPIENT.

We will use your short, personalized message to insert into the first paragraph of the letter.

We will use type-written (not hand-written) address labels.

As you can see, the point of this project is to send personalized letters to your friends and family from you, in order to gain support for David Ige from as many people as possible. Since the recipient will be receiving the letter from someone they know and trust, they are more likely to read the letter and take its message seriously.
