Precinct meetings are a vital part of the democratic process. Every Democrat who attends has an opportunity to appoint their designated Precinct and District officers for the 2018 election season, and also elect Delegates for the state and conventions.

If you are not already a Party member, please sign up now. (It's free, and you need to be a member to vote at the Caucus meeting). Here's the [online registration](#).

This year, the State Convention will be held on May 26 - 27 at the Hilton Waikoloa Village, on the Big Island of Hawai'i (you can decide later whether to attend).

Once elected, precinct officers will play an important role to ensure Party Organization. These officers are responsible for promoting the biennial precinct meetings and rallying the local community to become more involved in the democratic process.

Delegates are selected during an off-election year to establish the party's platform at the State Convention. Their roles will:

- Elect the Chairperson of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i
- Choose the members of the State Central Committee
- Debate any changes to the Constitutions of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i and adoptions to any new resolutions.

Remember, only residents in your precinct can vote for you, so make sure to invite your friends and family to participate.
