One year ago, Governor David Ige issued an executive order to protect Net Neutrality and a free and open internet. Even though the Federal Communications Commission voted to end Net Neutrality in a 3-2 decision at the end of 2017, Governor Ige's executive order protects state employees' right to use the internet for innovation, education, and free expression and it

impacts our daily lives.



Governor Ige was one of the first state leaders to sign an executive order to require internet service providers that contract with state agencies to abide by Net Neutrality. Net Neutrality guarantees equal access to the internet and prevents internet service providers from high speeds on sites they don't favor. This protection is essential to Hawai'i's small businesses and to the general public.
