We are making progress on affordable housing! **According to the Star Advertiser**, for the second year in a row, there are **fewer homeless people in Hawai'i**, and for the first time in 9 years, the homeless population on Oahu has decreased in size. Governor Ige is continuing to work tirelessly toward his **goal of 10,000 new affordable housing units by 2020**.

But there is still much to do -- despite this past year's **10% drop in homelessness**, there are still 6,530 homeless people on the islands.
