Aloha Friend,

This week, Hawai'i experienced historic rainfalls and flooding throughout the state and Governor Ige has taken measurable steps to provide relief to our 'ohana on Kaua'i and now, Honolulu.

Yesterday, Governor Ige signed a supplementary emergency proclamation declaring the City and County of Honolulu a disaster area after flooding caused heavy damage in East Honolulu – from Niu Valley to Waimānalo. This is a supplementary proclamation expanding on the original emergency proclamation for Kaua'i, authorizing expenditure of state monies to be appropriated to provide quick relief of damage caused by floods.

Furthermore, Governor Ige continues to help the people of Kaua'i, ensuring public safety and enforcing the state Department of Taxation to provide tax relief for Kaua'i residents affected by the floods and landslides. Residents will be eligible to file for an extension on their state tax returns, claim casualty loss deductions, or deduct their losses on their 2018 income tax returns.

**Governor Ige's leadership has always been about putting the people of Hawai'i first because this is his home. His actions continue to prove that he does the right things for the right reasons.**
